San Antonians are sure to “go native” at the 2<sup>nd</sup> annual Native San Antonio! on Saturday, March 26, 2011, at the beautiful Land Heritage Institute from 10 am to 2 pm. This fun-filled outdoor festival celebrates all things native to San Antonio while educating visitors about the incredible resources in our own backyard. The Native Plant Society of Texas-San Antonio is inviting environmentally related community organizations to be an exhibitor or vendor at this educational event.

Last spring, the first Native San Antonio! drew hundreds, who enjoyed hearing from keynote speakers Phil Hardberger and Howard Peak, both former mayors. This year, we aim to educate and encourage over 500 participants to responsibly use and preserve our native environmental, cultural and recreational resources, with a special emphasis on using native plants in their yards to conserve water and reduce fertilizers, insecticides, and herbicides. In addition, being exposed to the historical Land Heritage Institute on the Medina River will help local residents learn about the city’s rich cultural and environmental heritage and will encourage them to use our parks and greenways to promote their physical and mental health.

Native San Antonio! 2011 will feature a native tree give-away; a native plant sale; interpretive nature walks for adults and children; hands-on family activities; music by local performers; Native American hot rocks cooking demonstrations; a glimpse into local ranching history with chuck wagon demonstrations, hay rides and native Texas longhorn viewing; exhibits; presentations about outdoor, environmental, and conservation topics; vendors of locally made arts and crafts; and perhaps a farmers’ market selling local produce. Lunch and snacks will be available for purchase.

Participation as an Exhibitor is free if you provide your own table & chairs. If you wish to have NPSOT provide a 6ft. table & 2 chairs, a \$15 fee applies. There will be no power outlet available except by special arrangement. If you wish to sell items, you will need to apply as a vendor. Contact Jerry Morrisey, jlmorrisey@aol.com for pre-approval. If accepted, there will a \$25 fee plus a \$15 fee if we provide table & chairs.

Setup access is from 8 AM to 9:30 AM and your exhibit should be ready for the public by 9:45 AM to accommodate early arrivals. Breakdown starts at 2 PM. If you need to setup on Friday afternoon, we can probably make arrangements but there will be no security available.

Directions: The Land Heritage Institute is on the south side of the Medina River across from the Toyota Manufacturing Plant. It can be reached from the intersection of Loop 410 and Hwy 16 by travelling south to a traffic light at Lone Star Pass. Turn left and follow Lone Star Pass to Applewhite Road. Turn right on Applewhite and follow it across the Medina River to its first intersection which is Neal Road. Turn left and travel about 1.2 miles to the entrance of LHI which is through a gate on the left.

On site you will be directed to your exhibit spot by volunteers. Once you have unloaded your materials, you will need to park your vehicle at a designated site. A hayride will be available to the exhibit site. There will be food and water available for purchase at the event.
